

Sainsbury Centre

Parking for visitors is located in the Central Car Park. From early summer 2007 a new dedicated Sainsbury Centre Car Park will be available opposite the Gallery.

Sportspark

A parking ticket validation machine has been provided in the Sportspark foyer to allow Sportspark members to use the University's main car park during the evenings and at weekends without charge. Please contact Sportspark for further details.

Health Centre/Dental Practice

Please park in the main car park. Patients for the above practices will not be charged for parking. Staff at the Health Centre will validate your ticket allowing free exit from the main car park.

Blue Badge Holders

Blue Badge Holders will be required to pay to park their vehicles when attending as a general visitor. Every effort will be made to direct Blue Badge Holders to car parking spaces close to the destination on campus. Blue Badge Holders must not park on yellow lines except by prior arrangement with the The Lodge. Please contact the Transport Assistant if you require further help or information.

Overnight Parking

The main car park will close at 2.00am. Overnight Parking is strictly at the discretion and authorisation of The Lodge and charged at the appropriate tariff. Unauthorised vehicles will be clamped.

Visitor Car Park Charges

Monday to Friday between 06.00 and 14.00 £1.00 per hour. A flat fee of £1.00 applies at all other times. Please ensure you have the correct change available.

Fines and other Charges

Visitors who breach University Vehicle regulations will be clamped.

Whilst we do not charge a fee to remove the clamp we must advise that the removal of clamps is not a priority task and will be undertaken as soon as possible, depending on other competing demands on the Security Services.

Main Car Park Lost Ticket Fee: £15.00.

Bus Services:

The University benefits from the most frequent bus services in Norwich and is served directly by:

Service 25

(Rail Station – City Centre – Unthank Road – UEA) every 10 minutes throughout the day and evening, and every 30 minutes throughout the night.

Service 26/27

(Hellesdon – Aylsham Road – City Centre – Earlham Road – UEA) every 15 minutes from 06.00 until 02.40.

Service 22

(Sprowston – City Centre – Bowthorpe – Hospital – UEA) every 15 minutes from 06.00 until 23.44.

An annual season ticket is available to all campus card holders over 18 years of age. The ticket reduces the cost of an Annual First Bus Season Ticket by around 70%.

The ticket provides unlimited travel across Norwich City Zones 1-5 which means you can use your ticket for journeys other than to Campus. Tickets and full details are available from the Student Union Travel Shop, the Square.
