

### **RCEM Examinations**

Introduction to New Examination Structure

Applicable from August 2016

## APPROVAL OF EXAM

- All exam changes now APPROVED
- Approved by GMC November 2015 and information available on website
- MRCEM and FRCEM replaced by suite of exams leading to Fellowship of the College (FRCEM)
- MRCEM still available by passing a mix of the new examinations + MRCEM OSCE

#### FRCEM PRIMARY EXAM

- MRCEM Part A replaced by FRCEM Primary from August 16
- Change from True/False MCQ to SBAQ
- 180 questions in 3 hours
- Standard setting using Angoff method (no correction for standard error)
- Passes since August 2012 remain valid but four year ruling then discontinued
- Maximum 6 attempts

### INTERMEDIATE CERTIFICATE

- MRCEM Part B and C replaced with FRCEM Intermediate Certificate
  - Short Answer Question (SAQ) Paper 60 x 3 mark questions in 3 hours
  - Situational Judgement Paper (SJP) 120 SBAQ in 2 hours
- Held same day but can be sat and passed independently
- No award of MRCEM

# INTERMEDIATE SAQ

- MRCEM Part B SAQ replaced with FRCEM Intermediate SAQ from August 16
- Passes since August 2012 remain valid
- Standard setting Angoff Method + 1 Standard Error of Measurement (SEM)
- No restriction of currency of pass
- Maximum 6 attempts

# INTERMEDIATE SJP

- For trainees the MRCEM Part C (OSCE) will remain a GMC approved qualification for CCT if passed up to and prior to Aug 18
- After this required to pass SJP to sit the FRCEM Final exam components and for entry to ST4
- SJP introduced from Aug 17
- Standard setting Angoff Method + 1 SEM
- No restriction in currency and maximum 6 attempts

# MRCEM OSCE

- After Aug 18 MRCEM OSCE will still run for interested UK trainees and for nontrainees in UK and overseas
- Award of Membership by exam and postnominals - need to pass
  - MRCEM A/FRCEM Primary
  - MRCEM B/FRCEM Intermediate SAQ and
  - MRCEM OSCE
- Standard setting for OSCE Borderline Regression and 1 SEM

### FRCEM CRITICAL APPRAISAL

- Can be sat once passed MRCEM / FRCEM Primary
  + FRCEM Intermediate Certificate
- Slight change in marking criteria with the use of domain marking matrix
- From Aug 16 maximum of 4 attempts

### FRCEM MANAGEMENT

- FRCEM Management Viva remains part of the exam till Aug 18
- After this move to management portfolio -WPBA
- Current ST3s need to start compiling management portfolios
- Management Viva removed from exam from Aug 18 but management still assessed in clinical setting within FRCEM Final OSCE

# FRCEM CTR/QIP

- FRCEM CTR continues to run until Spring/Summer 18
- Can submit a QIP instead as per current GMC guidance
- CTR/QIP will include a viva until Aug 18
- FRCEM Quality Improvement Project formally introduced from Aug 18
- FRCEM QIP (post Aug 18) will be centrally marked at college but NO viva
- From Aug 16 maximum of 4 attempts

# FRCEM SAQ


- From Aug 16 changed to 60 x 3 mark questions in 3 hours
- There will be linking of questions for depth
- Decoupling of clinical components of FRCEM so can pass SAQ and OSCE independently
- Extended blueprint, mapped to curriculum
- Use of Angoff + 1 SEM
- Maximum of 4 attempts

## FINAL FRCEM OSCE

- No change to format
- Move to Borderline Regression + 1 SEM from n2p
- Maximum of 4 attempts
