Some activities of previous IMG Support Fellows

<u>Dr Yulia Maksunova – previous IMG Support Fellow for Cambridge and Peterborough</u>

A summary of activities over the last year:

- Organising welcome session and Transition Project induction.
- Workshops for ST1s in Peterborough on writing clinical case reviews and introduction to reflective e-portfolio writing.
- Post-CCT visa talks with Alex Ho I presented it at the IMG conference, and Alex and I delivered a series of sessions to trainees. I also presented it to practice managers in Cambridge and Peterborough. I have tried to see if ICB can refund practices for sponsorship but have been advised that, at present, it is not possible. It could change in the future.
- AKT exam prep sessions with mock exams, as described in my recent essay.

<u>Dr Anindya Sanyal (Rony) – previous IMG Support Fellow for Suffolk and North-East Essex</u>

Part A: Offering mentoring and support to IMGs across the patch. I have had students approach in and we have completed 1:1 sessions focused on preparation for their SCA examinations.

Part B: I have engaged with relevant stakeholders to create and refine an innovative group based communication skills teaching session for all trainees but with a specific focus on identifying and overcoming challenge IMGs face with the interpersonal skills domain in the SCA examination. I have delivered this session 4 times in total, 3 virtual teaching sessions, 1 face to face session.

Part C: I have created a presentation on Professionalism within the NHS and used it to deliver a virtual teaching session to a cohort of students in Colchester. The objectives of the session were:

- To gain an understanding of what it means to be professional within the NHS
- To test knowledge and understanding on professional behaviours within NHS work environments

- To understand your learning needs in order to plan how you are going to develop your professionalism skills over the next few years.

It has been well received (see appendix 2) and I am planning to hand over the feedback from it to my colleague Shoba who is taking over from my role this year, with the hope she can deliver further sessions and refine it.

Dr Alex Ho – previous IMG Support Fellow in Mid and South Essex

- Ran webinar series to VTS schemes including exam help, how to get a GP job post CCT and how to navigate visas for international medical graduates some webinars were attended by >100 trainees.
- Taught on communications skills courses in person and virtually to trainees with good feedback.
- 121 ad hoc support for trainees in difficulty or those needing extra support for exams / job hunt.
- Collaborated in national project trying to improve workforce culture in primary care including how to be more inclusive and in particular anti-racist ongoing project.
- Collaborated in HEE write up of how to support trainees who have been bullied or harassed this featured my previous project work as the EoE inclusivity fellow.
- Presented poster on International Medical Graduate post CCT visas at National conference.
- Currently completing PG Cert in healthcare practice with project work focussing around IMG visas (due to complete 2025 due to Mat leave).

Dr Ashba Jafri – previous IMG Support Fellow in Hertfordshire and West Essex

- Carried out survey of GP Trainers on their views of IMG GP Trainees (see appendix 3).
- Written E module to help GP Trainers better support their GP Trainees.
