BAETS MASTERCLASS - ROYAL COLLEGE OF SURGEONS, LONDON

As an intensive one-day interactive workshop on surgery of the thyroid and parathyroid, this course aims to give you the opportunity to receive teaching on controversial areas of thyroid and parathyroid surgery with group discussions, short lectures with discussion and an emphasis on interactive teaching style (6 CPD Points)

SKILLS TRAINING (WET AND DRY LAB) - ESI, HAMBURG

This two day course is held at the European Surgical Institute in Hamburg. The first day will include discussion on efficiencies within theatre and the patient pathway and dry lab dissection using both advanced bipolar and ultrasonic technology. The second day will take place in the wet lab performing a variety of procedures under close supervision

ON AND OFF SITE TRAINING

One-to-one dedicated instruction for on and off site training in order for the trainee to learn in key skills and steps for Endocrine, Head and Neck and Thyroid procedures to perfect their skills
