

Study Leave Application Process



Payment will be made to the trainee at the earliest opportunity and

curriculum requirements (up to £600)

- These are activities that have been explicitly identified as requirements of the trainee's specialty's curriculum and/or ARCP decision aid
- Activities can be signed off at Trust level provided the total cost (including the costs of the activity, travel and subsistence) is £600 or less
- The costs of examination fees, although they are curriculum requirements, must be paid for by the trainee and will not be reimbursed from the study leave budget

aspirational activity (> £600)

- These are activities that are not explicitly identified as requirements of the trainee's specialty's curriculum and/or ARCP decision aid but may help the trainee complete parts of the curriculum and/or develop their career
- It is essential that any aspirational activity is included in the trainee's PDP
- Ideal to apply for locally available courses
- Applications always require additional sign off from the TPD (or Head of School if TPD is unavailable)
- Supporting statement from the trainee/ ES
- Outcome 1 or 6 if in the last year of training
- Aspirational activities should be in-line with the current level of training for that trainee

- Less than full time (LTFT) and academic trainees have equitable access to study leave funding
- Study leave enabling trainees to achieve their curriculum outcomes
- Consideration of discretionary study leave that is career enhancing activity or that adds value to the individual and/or supports the wider system
- Attendance at courses/conferences should be taken as close to the base of the individual as possible (please book for courses within the deanery)
- Trainee needs to follow the local processes for applying the study leave

- Educational supervisor plays a key role
- The support required to achieve curriculum outcomes should be discussed and agreed by the individual and supervisor
- > The activity should meet the educational needs of the individual
- It should be clear how educational activity will support achievement of curriculum outcomes and how the activity will help the individual to improve the care they are able to provide to patients or related activities

- Not eligible to apply when OOP
- Not eligible to apply during period of grace
- Study leave would not usually be permitted during periods of sick leave ('SuppoRTT')
- National emergencies

Study leave for exams:

- 1. one private preparation course per attempt at a part of an exam would usually be funded for up to three attempts per part of the exam
- 2. The funding offered per attempt will usually include relevant travel, accommodation, and subsistence costs plus up to a maximum of £750 for course fees. The one funded course can be either face to face or virtual (including question banks). Where a course provider runs separate courses for different sections of a part of an exam, only one of these courses will usually be funded.

Overnight allowance

- Please chose courses as per curriculum requirements and also as per your PDP/ SITM requirements
