10th Food Allergy Day

This day is aimed at all health care professionals who see children and adults with food allergy in their day-to-day practice.

Key Concepts in Allergy Day

The aim of this course is to provide delegates with the knowledge and skills required to assess, diagnose and manage the allergic patient. There will be separate sessions, dedicated to the whole spectrum of allergic disease, including food allergy, allergic rhinitis, asthma and atopic eczema.

Molecular Diagnostics in Practice Day

This study day will look into the increasing role of component resolved diagnostics in our day-to- day practice, with practical case presentations illustrating the current use of molecular diagnostics in adult and paediatric allergy management.

Practical Allergy in Primary Care
