Out of Hours guidance – October 2011

Under EWTR it is permissible to work a week at a time as hours get 'counted' across a longer time period.

However under the Junior Doctors New Deal it is **NOT** possible to work a week at a time nor more than two days consecutively. This means that weekends must be split Friday and then Saturday/Sunday.

Therefore under Agenda for Change although it would be possible for the PBOTM registrars to comply with EWTR, medical registrars must comply with both EWTR and the New Deal.

In order to maintain parity the programme will work to the new Deal regulations ie not full weeks and only split weekends.
