



EFFECTIVE OUT OF HOURS PRACTICE WORKSHOPS

HEEEoE are collaborating with the RCGP to provide a free, four part, Effective Out of Hours Practice series, designed to assist GP trainees working towards their urgent and unscheduled care competencies.

This online series of workshops are running exclusively for East of England GP trainees.

Each workshop will last two hours, providing an overview of key knowledge and skills required to undertake out of hours work. The webinars explore some of the differences between out of hours work and daytime general practice, including, remote assessment, decision-making, lack of continuity of care and limited access to the electronic medical record.

- workshop one will cover emergency work, safeguarding, complaints and personal safety
- workshop two will cover special group/COVID-19, ethical dilemma and organisational aspect
- workshop three will cover laboratory results, palliative care and telephone triage
- workshop four will cover sepsis, mental health and challenging situations.

GP trainees are required to undertake the full four-part series in order to complete the course. You must register for each workshop separately using the links sent to you by the RCGP.
