How to find us



From the North and West

≥ A14. Around the North of Newmarket. Off on A142 (signed Ely). Turn left, 50 metres turn right (signed Snailwell). 1 mile, at 30mph sign, turn right and immediately right. 1/2 mile under A14, entrance on left.

From the East

≥ A14. Around the North of Newmarket, come off on the A142 (signed Ely). Turn right, over A14 and after 50 meters turn right (signed Snailwell). After 1 mile, at 30mph sign, turn right and immediately right. After 1/2 mile, under A14, entrance on left.



From the South

Bishop'

≥ M11. Off at junction 9 (A11) to Six Mile Bottom. Take A1304 signed Newmarket. Up High Street to Clock Tower. Turn left (A142 signed Ely) 1/2 mile turn right signed Snailwell (Snailwell Road). 1 mile railway bridge, entrance on right.
