



East of England Global Health Fellowships

Open to doctors, nurses and AHPs in training in the East of England

The Global Health Fellowships (GHFs) provide opportunity to doctors, nurses and AHPs in training in the East of England to develop greater understanding and participate in global health activities.

GHFs are offered to:

- Doctors in training (ST3+) all specialties
- Nurses doing preceptorship
- AHPs in final year of training

GHFs can expect to:

- Have funded time (up to one session per week) to dedicate to global health activities.
- Gain understanding of Global Health and skills in team working, leadership and management and governance, alongside their speciality knowledge and skills.
- Experience partnership working with health care professionals in Low- and Middle-Income countries through one of the existing global Health Partnerships in the region with Cambridge Global Health Partnerships or another defined partnership.
- Be offered development against a number of specific curriculum competencies.
- Undertake an overseas partnership visit.
- Have the opportunity to study for a Global Health qualification (partial funding available)
- Become a champion for global health within their profession and the region.
- Join a support network for international staff working in the region with involvement in induction and mentorship.

Eligibility

Open to trainees in East of England at ST3 or above (at start of fellowship), to nurses during preceptorship and AHPs in final year of training. GHF posts are offered for 1 year subject to funding, satisfactory progression and agreed educational objectives. The GHF will be expected to work within an established health partnership working on existing projects or developing new ideas within the partnership and taking these forwards. The specific work undertaken will depend on the interests of the GHF and agreement of HEE EoE supervisor – this may involve teaching, audit, guideline development and research.
