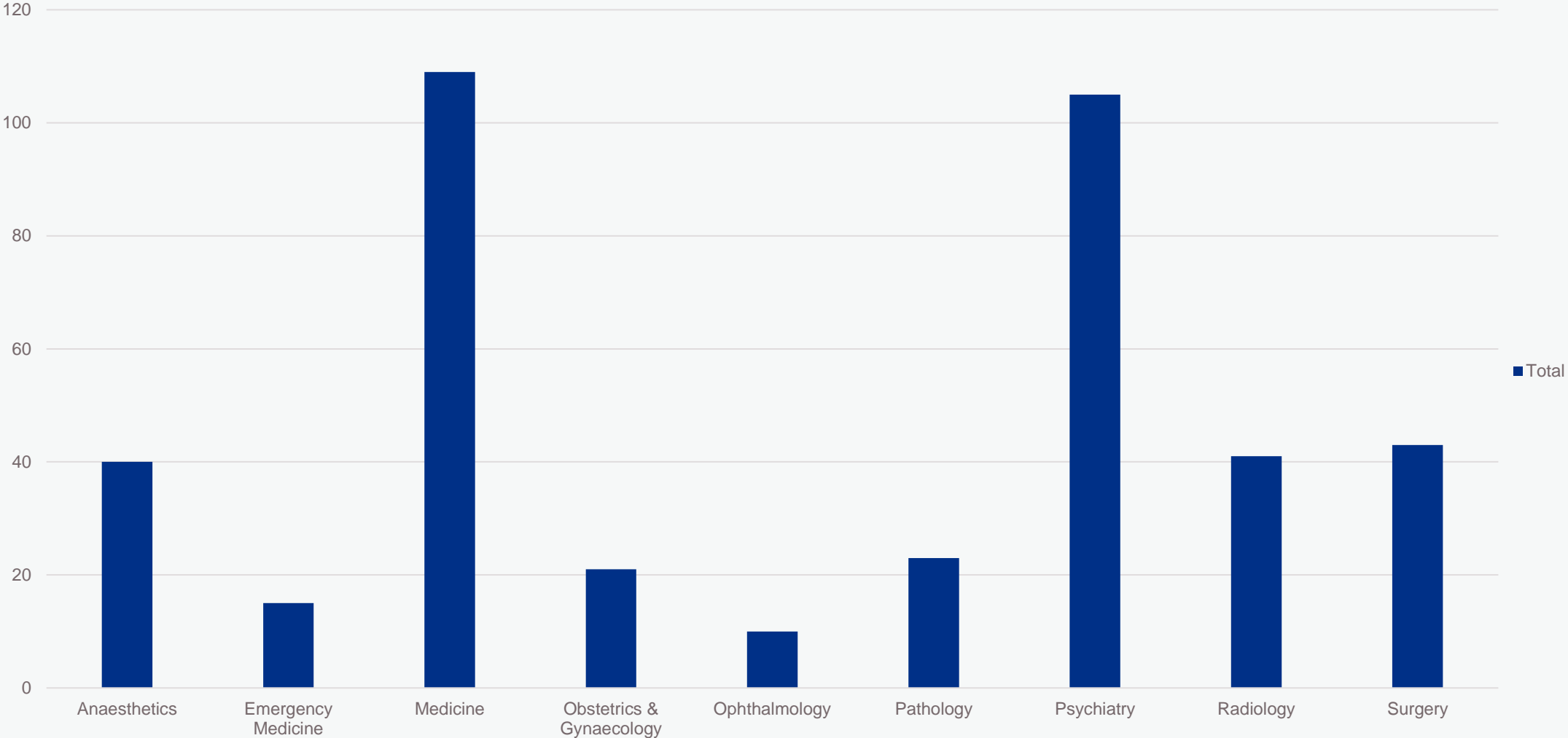

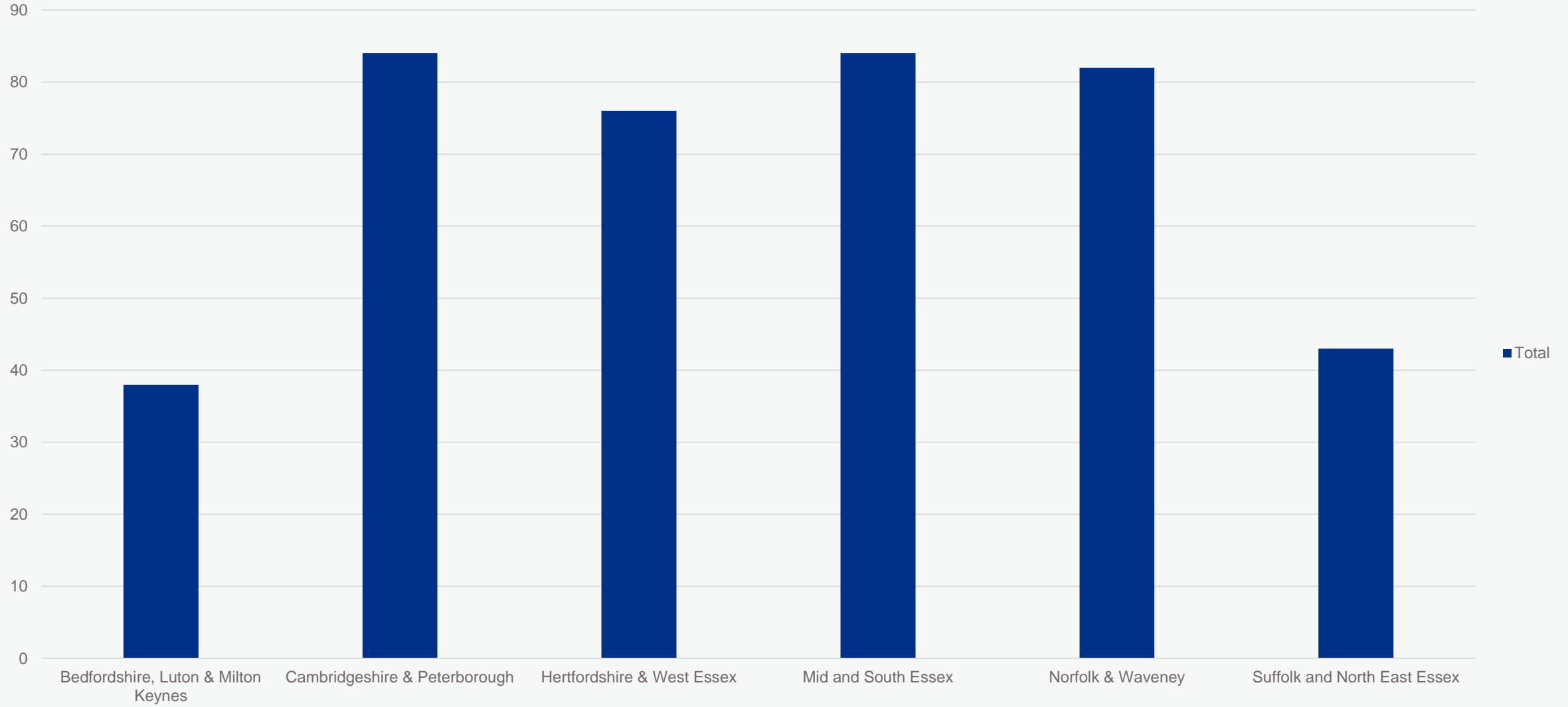


Total Expansion in EOE between 2021 - 2024 - by School



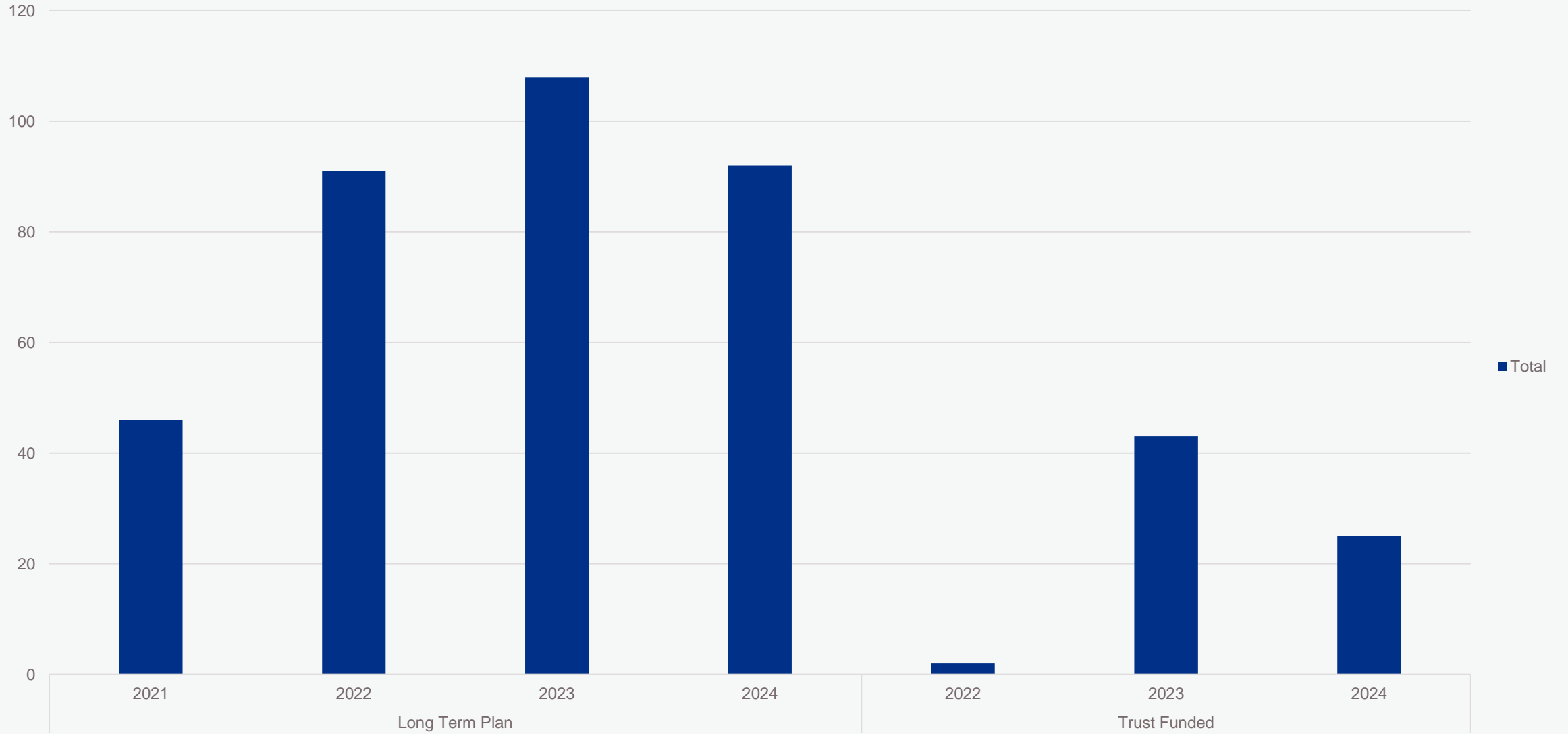


Total Expansion in EOE between 2021 - 2024 - by ICB

Challenges of the Programmes

Balancing Distribution & Expansion

- Ensuring we are not causing instability within each programme

Support for Service Provision

- If we are losing training posts, how else can patient care be supported?
- LED/SAS? PAs?

Financial Challenges

- Tariff Funding
- What if the Trust cannot fund the remaining salary?

Educational Capacity

- Are there enough supervisors?

Premises / Facilities

- Are there enough clinic rooms?
- Equipment challenges

Curriculum Coverage

- Need for specialist posts to cover some curriculum requirements
- Implications of outsourcing
