

Dental Workforce Development and Continuing Professional Development plans for 2020-2021

An update from Health Education England Midlands and East Dental School

This is an update of the Dental Workforce Development programme provided by Health Education England working across the Midlands & East (HEE M&E). We endeavour to provide a programme of education to support and develop the dental teams in the region. During this complex and stressful time, we are keen to continue in this role and assist in any way we can.

HEE M&E covers a very large geographic area, from scenic coastlines and open countryside to bustling rural market towns and busy cities. This geographic diversity has attracted dental professionals from all over the UK, Europe and worldwide to train, educate and practice the various branches of dentistry. HEE M&E's area covers a huge area from the Welsh Border to the most Eastern tip of England. To meet the needs of such a diverse population and the teams that serve them we are looking to change and develop our offering to suit the current problems and be prepared for the future.

As many staff may be furloughed or working reduced hours, we have developed a suite of e-Learning that can be accessed remotely. This is a time to check your PDP and complete that vital learning and development that all dental team members need:

e-Learning for Healthcare

e-Learning for Healthcare is a HEE programme which works in partnership with NHS and professional bodies to support patient care by providing e-learning. In the past, it has not been possible to download GDC e-CPD compliant certificates for all courses which are helpful to dental teams. We have worked with e-Learning for Healthcare to generate Enhanced GDC CPD compliant certificates for the following courses:

If you are not already registered with e-Learning for Healthcare, you will need to do this by accessing the e-Learning for Healthcare home page: <u>https://www.e-lfh.org.uk/.</u> Once logged in, the full list of programmes (including those featured in more detail below) is available on the e-LfH Hub "Full Catalogue" page. Once you have completed any of the above courses, you must first generate a course completion certificate from the e-LfH Hub.

Following this you must complete the relevant Enhanced CPD form, referring to the course completion certificate. The Enhanced CPD forms can be accessed from the bottom of the "Dentistry" page of e-LfH in the "Enhanced CPD" section <u>https://www.e-lfh.org.uk/programmes/dentistry/.</u> Please note that both the relevant course Enhanced CPD form and the accompanying e-LfH Hub course completion certificate should be kept as evidence in your records to demonstrate you have completed verifiable CPD, should the GDC request it.

e-Learning for Healthcare - e-Den

E-Den is an engaging and interactive learning resource delivered through a partnership between the Royal College of Surgeons of England and Health Education England e-Learning for Healthcare.

The e-Den curriculum is designed to develop a competent, caring, reflective practitioner. Educational content covers many branches of dentistry and supports the continual professional development (CPD) of dental care professionals and experienced dentists. Sessions have been written by subject specialists and are typically 20 minutes long. Users can dip in and out of the sessions as they wish. The aim is to provide an engaging and interactive learning resource that is compatible with a busy professional life.

GDC Enhanced CPD compliant CPD is available for all modules. The Enhanced CPD forms can be accessed from the bottom of the "Dentistry" page of e-LfH in the Enhanced CPD section <u>https://www.e-</u> <u>lfh.org.uk/programmes/dentistry/</u>. Please note that both the relevant course Enhanced CPD form and the accompanying e-LfH Hub course completion certificate should be kept as evidence in your records to demonstrate you have completed verifiable CPD, should the GDC request it.

e-Learning for Healthcare – Children's Oral Health Advice for All

Children's Oral Health Advice for All aims to improve the knowledge of the general public and early years healthcare workers regarding children's oral health. It introduces Delivering Better Oral Health to non-clinical staff providing appropriate evidence to support key messages. It also introduces learners to ways in which they can support parents to develop good oral health habits through effective behaviour change conversations. This resource can be used to upskill the entire dental team including those performing reception or other non-clinical duties.

e-Learning for Healthcare - Dental Health module of RCPCH Healthy Child Programme

The Dental Health Promotion module of the Royal College of Paediatrics and Child Health's Healthy Child Programme aims to enhance the knowledge and skills of those who engage with children regarding oral health and factors that predispose to poor oral health. Promoting oral health in the infant and young child forms an integral part of this session.

All e-Learning for Healthcare courses are available immediately and are free of charge.

GDC Enhanced CPD course

Changes to the GDC requirements regarding CPD were rolled out starting on 1 January 2019. All registrants are now required to have a Personal Development Plan, complete GDC Enhanced CPD and evidence this. To assist registrants with achieving the new expectations in a GDC compliant way, HEE have worked with Cambridge University Hospitals Foundation Trust and developed a free of charge online leaning course which also provides one hour of GDC compliant CPD. SCRIPT licences

Dental SCRIPT is an e-learning programme which improves prescribing competency and safety among dentists. It consists of eight modules covering a range of dental prescribing situations. Midlands and East Dental School will fund free of charge licences for the first 600 applicants. At this very difficult time many of us find ourselves overwhelmed and stressed. Stress in the dental team has always been a risk, but we now have extra pressures to deal with. Fortunately, we have a range of online courses to help support the mental health & wellbeing of our dental teams.

Mental Health and Wellbeing

We have worked with Embrace Resilience to commission four online courses. The courses are all provided free of charge and are available for all dental team members including those who are not on the dental register. The courses are:

- Change and Resilience this course covers behaviour change and how to build personal resilience
- Mental Health: Body and Mind this course explains the links between physical and mental health and enables learners to establish routines beneficial for the mind and body
- Managing Stress and Anxiety this course will assist learners to manage everyday causes of anxiety and resultant stress
- Work-Life Balance this course explores the balance between work commitments and other interests to support learners to achieve a work-life balance which improves their health.

To enable an inclusive approach for all practice team members to avail of this support, it is not necessary to input a GDC number as part of the registration process. All participants can download a certificate which demonstrates two hours CPD for each course. For those with a GDC number, this certificate complies with the GDC Enhanced CPD requirements. We hope that this initiative will be welcomed by practices and individuals to address and demonstrate their engagement in supporting the important issue of the mental health and wellbeing of all the team. Mentoring courses

HEE is currently procuring mentoring courses in response to requests from LDC Chairs and other stakeholders. The courses are designed to develop dentists who provide support and mentoring via Practitioner Advice and Support Services (PASS schemes) and/or supervision and mentoring to trainees, PLVE and conditionally included dentists. Dental CPD conference

HEE is also currently investigating the procurement of a large dental CPD conference as requested by many delegates. The current situation may impact this type of event, but we will aim to deliver this learning & networking opportunity if possible.
