# What are HUB days?

Mandatory training in FY1 and FY2 consisting of clinical and non-clinical sessions

### How do I record my attendance?

Following a Hub Session, certificates will be issued (either emailed to you directly or uploaded onto Bridge). These can then be used as evidence of attendance, to be uploaded onto Horus.

### Are the sessions online or in person?

This varies between sessions.

Due to Covid restrictions, many sessions have been made virtual to allow for safe, remote learning.

How many Hub Days are required?

# 2 Clinical Hub Days 1 Non-Clinical Hub Day

Two half day sessions (or on full day session) should be clinical and the other should be non-clinical or relate to professionalism.

### Are Hub Sessions mandatory?

Yes! Attendance at *3 sessions* is nonnegotiable and non-attendance will be recorded on e-portfolio unless there are exceptional circumstances

#### Do I need to book study leave?

We advise that you request study leave as soon as possible once signing up for your sessions as this cannot always be guaranteed if left too close to the date of the session.

## Are there a limited number of spaces?
