

## Individual Study Leave Curriculum Requirements for School of Emergency Medicine

Individual Requirements: For courses mandated by the curriculum in order to meet CCT requirements, that are not currently being funded centrally, the resident doctor will need to apply for reimbursement of their costs via their LEP's study leave application process, as outlined in the flowchart available <u>here</u>. If the total cost of the activity (including course fees, travel, accommodation and subsistence) exceeds £600 and requires additional sign off from the TPD, the resident doctor will need to follow the local study leave application process *and* complete the NHSE EoE approval form available <u>here</u>.

Funding for activities not identified on this list will need to be applied for as an aspirational activity. The resident doctor will need to follow the local study leave application process *and* complete the NHSE EoE approval form available <u>here.</u>
