

Individual Study Leave Curriculum Requirements for School of Pathology

Individual Requirements: For courses mandated by the curriculum in order to meet CCT requirements, that are not currently being funded centrally, the postgraduate doctor in training (PGDiT) will need to apply for reimbursement of their costs via their LEP's study leave application process, as outlined in the flowchart available here. If the total cost of the activity (including course fees, travel, accommodation and subsistence) exceeds £600 and requires additional sign off from the TPD, the PGDiT will need to follow the local study leave application process and complete the HEE EoE approval form available here.

Funding for activities not identified on this list will need to be applied for as an aspirational activity. The PGDiT will need to follow the local study leave application process *and* complete the HEE EoE approval form available here.
