#### Introduction from Prof Shahid Khan, Associate Dean for SAS Doctors and LEDs

COVID-19 has been a catalyst for change in every walk of life and its impact is likely to be felt for years to come. Among others, the long-term effect of stress on health care workers is gradually surfacing. There is evidence for increased rates of PTSD and burnout in the medical workforce. Understandably peer support during these difficult times is important and everyone needs to reach out to colleagues who may be showing signs of vulnerability. Despite efforts, referrals to Professional Support & Welfare Services (PSW) for SAS & LEDs have been negligible and this may be due to lack of awareness. SAS / LED Tutors in Trusts will be able to help with referrals.

The course of events over the past few months have made us rethink the way education and training is delivered. There is more flexibility in the system and currently there are new avenues to explore. One such opportunity is Panopto/Bridge Fellows. HEE EoE are creating short-term Fellowships for blended learning parts of the Panopto project. The Fellows will be creating content and organising content into courses. There will be approximately 12 Fellows working 2 days a week across all specialities. SAS/LED are able to compete for these Fellowships and is an ideal opportunity for colleagues with interest in education to broaden their horizon. Look out for the advert in the near future.

Leadership Programme for SAS: An extensive three-day programme of Leadership has been planned in partnership with MIAD. The programme is focused on personal effectiveness, time & stress management, teamwork, business management & clinical governance.

The programme will start in February 2021 and the days will be spaced out over a six-week period. Places will be limited to 15 and there is likely to be tough competition for a place on the course. The dates for the programme will be advertised soon.

Two attached documents from the Academy of Medical Royal Colleges make important reading for everyone. They touch upon important areas for SAS doctors including better support for SAS doctors and recommendation to increase SAS involvement in research.



#### Individual requests for funding

Many face-to-face training courses have been cancelled, and we therefore expect a decrease in individual funding requests. However, we would like to inform you that we are accepting individual funding requests as there may be some of you who are looking to complete online courses or re-certifications. Applications will be accepted up until 12:00 noon on 31st January 2021.
