**The Practice**

We are a small friendly rural practice with a list size of 4000 patients. We work out of three purpose built surgery buildings with two on-site dispensaries and ample car parking facilities. All sites provide full disabled access.

Our practice area on the beautiful Suffolk coast stretches from the River Deben in the south to the River Alde/Ore in the north. This large rural area inevitably affects the way we work. However we are determined to provide an exceptional ever improving service where getting appointments, establishing diagnoses, treating promptly and individually as well as referring onto hospital when appropriate, are priorities.

In September 2012 the practice will migrate to the SystmOne clinical system. We will continue to offer ten minute appointment times along with telephone access and home visits, where appropriate. This will enhance the close working links that we already have with our district nursing team.

**The Training**

We will provide both protected time for formal teaching but also with an open door policy for all staff, we believe in being able to talk whenever you want. The Registrar will be involved in holding their own surgeries, making home visits, undertaking on call duties and are expected to attend practice partners and clinical meetings where possible. Together we will develop a training package where both sides will learn from each other and enable the trainee to reach their full potential. We aim to offer a supportive stimulating environment to the GP Registrar
