

Reflective Practice for Doctors 0.5 day

'Reflection is part of learning and thinking. We reflect in order to learn something, or we learn as a result of reflecting, and the term reflective learning emphasises our intention to learn from current or prior experience.' *Moon*

Although the appraisal process has now become embedded, many doctors do not understand how to develop effective reflective accounts to demonstrate their practice both clinical and as Supervisors educationally.
