

# Return to Medical Training after a long career break



## Would you like to return to training after a career break, but not sure how to get back?

The east of England (EoE) Supported Return to Training (SuppoRTT) initiative has worked with the EoE Foundation Director to develop a process which provides access to training opportunities for doctors who have been away from medical training for three to five years and would like to return to training. This includes:

- 2 week Enhanced Shadowing
- Advanced Life Support course
- 6 week unpaid observership in clinical setting
- 4 month placement in a Foundation training post from April—August
- A variety of learning via E-Learning, Virtual Reality training & Face to face training

It is anticipated that doctors who complete this programme will be ready for a trust grade appointment and be in a position to apply via national recruitment in the Autumn following successful placement.
