

This course is designed to provide exam practice and feedback to improve exam technique in the SAQ section of the Final FRCA. The course comprises:

- An introductory day: 1030-1630, Monday 20th November 2017, Peterborough City Hospital. Exam discussion and explanation of the correspondence course.
- A SAQ correspondence course of four complete SAQ papers. Each paper is marked, annotated with feedback and returned to the candidate.
- Course culminates with an SAQ practice day: 0830-1730, Tuesday 20th February 2018, Peterborough City Hospital. Two mock SAQ exams under exam conditions, obscure topic revision session, discussion and feedback.
- 80 SAQs completed and marked during the course. Course is only for candidates sitting the March '18 exam. Candidates' answers are anonymized.
- Course is relatively new to this region but in existence since 2008 see January 2012 edition of RCOA Bulletin (Issue 71, Page 38-40) for more details.
