Important notes:

- Definition of Substantive post: permanent contract.
- Definition of SAS Doctor: group of senior doctors and dentists is comprised of specialty doctors, associate specialists, staff grades, hospital practitioners, clinical assistants, senior clinical medical officers and clinical medical officers. This group of staff is referred to as the Staff, Associate specialists and Specialty doctors (SAS) group. (BMA England https://www.bma.org.uk/media/1057/bma-sas-charter-for-england-dec-2014.pdf)
- Locally Employed Doctors (i.e. Trust Clinical or Education Fellows) are not eligible for these bursaries.
- The maximum amount of the bursary is £3,000. Please note that if University charges more you will need to seek alternative sources of funding for the difference.
- If you hold a visa the University may treat you as an international student. You may be subject to additive overseas student fees. Please check with the University before applying; HEE EoE will not meet these additional fees.
- Retrospective applications will not be considered.
- HEE EoE will not pay for travel, accommodation or subsistence.
