2. To have achieved all of the "Mandatory" targets set at the PYA assessment		
3. Valid ALS		
4. At least 1 audit assessment per training year		
5. Satisfactory no. of consultant SLEs - 1 ACAT, 6 CbD, 6 mini-CEX		
6. At least 4 separate MCRs for Geriatric Medicine (ES not allowed)		
7. To have attended a research methodology, teaching and management course		
8. SCE to have been passed		
9. To have completed a patient survey		
10. At least 1 Teaching Observation		
11. Satisfactory record of teaching attendance		
12. Curriculum coverage

1. A satisfactory separate ES report for each GIM year		
2. To have achieved all of the "Mandatory" targets set in the GIM PYA		
3. Valid ALS		
4. Satisfactory number of WBPA/SLEs – 10 in CCT year (at least 6 ACATs)		
5. At least 4 separate MCRs for GIM		
6. Need to have led at least 1 GIM audit or QIP by CCT (evidence with AA or QIPAT)		
7. Need to demonstrate that you have seen >1000 patients on Acute Take		
8. Need to have attended at least 186 clinics or equivalents		
9. Need at least 1 Teaching Observation		
10. Need to demonstrate that attended > 100 hours of External GIM		
11. Curriculum coverage – ES ratings at the group level
