

SuppoRTT - return to work training for junior doctors

Training to ensure all trainee clinicians are confident and fully supported when returning to practice following a sustained period of absence.

The programme offers:

- A mixture of relevant topic teaching, high fidelity simulation and practical skills support
- Semi-bespoke training for specific training requirements
- A study day involving simulation and refresher teaching on many areas of clinical practice, including clinical skills such as cannulation, lumbar puncture, catheterisation etc.

Who is eligible?

Junior doctors who have had a sustained period of absence of three months or more, due to paternity/maternity leave, sick leave, or who have been out of training and have accepted an East of England training post.
