Important notes:

- Locally Employed Doctors (i.e. Trust Clinical or Education Fellows) are not eligible for these bursaries.
- Core Trainees who have not been appointed to Higher Education training in EoE are not eligible for these bursaries.
- Core Trainees who have been offered Higher Education training post in EoE and have accepted a post are eligible for these bursaries. If post not taken up money will be reclaimed back from the University and candidate will be expected to cover the costs of the course.
- Foundation Trainees are not eligible for these bursaries.
- Run through programme Trainees who have training number are eligible for this funding (i.e. ACF etc.)
- The maximum amount of the bursary is £3,000. Please note that if University charges more you will need to seek alternative sources of funding for the difference.
- If you hold a visa the University may treat you as an international student. You may be subject to additive overseas student fees. Please check with the University before applying; HEE EoE will not meet these additional fees.
