<b>Level of experience</b>		An educational role; e.g. Trainee Rep on Trainee Forum or STC
<b>Teaching experience</b>	Minimum of 1 years' teaching experience at the time of applying	Evidence of involvement in developing, organising, and/or delivering teaching to doctors/dentists and healthcare practitioners in EoE
<b>Personal characteristics</b>	Honesty and probity	Reflective practitioner
<b>Skills</b>	Clear communicator with good writing and presentation skills, capable of constructing clear arguments	

## Important notes:

- Locally Employed Doctors (i.e. Trust Clinical or Education Fellows) are not eligible for these bursaries.
- Core Trainees who have not been appointed to Higher Education training in EoE are not eligible for these bursaries.
- Core Trainees who have been offered Higher Education training post in EoE and have accepted a post are eligible for these bursaries. If post not taken up money will be re-claimed back from the University and candidate will be expected to cover the costs of the course.
- Foundation Trainees are not eligible for these bursaries.
- Run through programme Trainees who have training number are eligible for this funding (i.e. ACF etc.)
- The maximum amount of the bursary is £3,000. Please note that if University charges more you will need to seek alternative sources of funding for the difference.
- If you hold a visa the University may treat you as an international student. You may be subject to additive overseas student fees. Please check with the University before applying; HEE EoE will not meet these additional fees.
